Gynaecomastia Reduction

Post Op Instructions



Rest

- ✓ Go home and rest.
- ✓ Elevate your head on 3-5 pillows for the first week and keep knees bent (to reduce swelling.)
- ✓ Flex calves when resting to help maintain leg circulation and reduce possibility of clots in veins.
- ✓ Overnight, remain within 1 hour's distance of the surgery in case of complications.

Bleeding

- ✓ Minor bleeding normal for first 24-48 hours post operatively.
- ✓ Heavy or prolonged bleeding or swelling on one side contact Dr Belt on the numbers below.

Wound Care

- √ The large adhesive dressing covering your chest must be kept dry and intact until your return to my rooms the day after your surgery.
- ✓ The support garment is to be worn over the dressing. Bring your garment to your 1st appointment.
- ✓ Limit arm movements, no pushing, pulling or lifting.
- ✓ Any drainage is to be recorded daily bring records to 1st visit to doctor's rooms. Do not remove drains.
- ✓ When directed by Dr Belt, apply tape to the wounds. This process continues for 3 months. Following this you will be instructed by Dr Belt to start using silicone scar gel to improve the quality of your scars.

Pain Relief

- ✓ A script will be provided for pain relief sufficient for one week. If you run out, Panadeine should be adequate.
- ✓ Do not take Aspirin (unless prescribed) as it prolongs bleeding.
- ✓ Contact Dr Belt if pain relief is inadequate.

Infection

- ✓ Please remember to take your antibiotics regularly as prescribed
- Wound infection is an infrequent occurrence. Contact Dr Belt if you experience:
 - Increased pain, temperature and flu-like symptoms
 - Widespread redness
 - Offensive discharge coming from the wound.

Exercise

- ✓ Avoid strenuous lifting, aerobic exercises and swimming for 6 weeks post-operatively.
- ✓ Try gentle exercise i.e. light walking
- ✓ Do not drive a motor vehicle for 7 days post-operatively.
- ✓ Avoid sexual activity for 2 weeks post operatively.

Emergency

At any time during office hours my Registered Nurse - Sally, is available to help with any concerns you might have pre & post operation. In the uncommon event that you cannot contact Dr Belt or his colleagues in an emergency, please present to Greenslopes Private Hospital Emergency Department for treatment.
