The implants can be placed either underneath the breast tissue itself, or underneath the breast (pectoralis) muscle. The size, shape and profile of the implants are also specifically selected in order to produce the ideal outcome for each individual patient.

Dr Belt aims to achieve natural looking results for patients and helps them achieve their desired goals.
